**WEEKLY WEATHER OUTLOOK
VALID FROM SEPTEMBER 4 TO 10, 2025**

Summary: During the review period, Monrovia, Robertsport, Saniquelle, Voinjama, and Zwedru are expected to receive heavy rainfall between September 4 and 5, while Buchanan and Greenville will experience moderate rainfall. From September 6 to 7, most cities are likely to observe fair weather conditions, followed by mixed weather patterns across many areas between September 8 and 10.

Monrovia, Montserrado County

- ❖ Thursday and Friday (September 4–5): Heavy rainfall is anticipated in Monrovia and its environs.
- ❖ Saturday (September 7): Fair weather with moderate rainfall is anticipated in Monrovia and its environs.
- ❖ Sunday (September 7): Fair weather is anticipated in Monrovia and its environs.
- ❖ Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday (September 8–10): Fair weather with moderate rainfall is anticipated in Monrovia and its environs.

Buchanan, Grand Bassa County

- ❖ Thursday and Friday (September 4-5): Moderate rainfall is anticipated in Buchanan and its environs.
- ❖ Saturday and Sunday (September 6–7): Fair weather is expected in Buchanan and its environs
- ❖ Monday and Tuesday (September 8-9): Fair weather with low rainfall is expected in Buchanan and its environs.
- ❖ Wednesday (September 10): Moderate rainfall is anticipated in Buchanan and its environs.

Greenville, Sinoe County

- ❖ Thursday (September 4): Moderate rainfall is anticipated in Greenville and its environs.
- ❖ Friday to Monday (September 5–8): Fair weather is anticipated in Greenville and its environs.
- ❖ Tuesday and Wednesday (September 9-10): Fair weather with low rainfall is expected in Greenville and its environs.

Robertsport, Grand Cape Mount County

- ❖ Thursday, Friday and Saturday (September 4–6): Heavy rainfall is expected in Robertsport and its environs.
- ❖ Sunday (September 7): Fair weather with traces of rainfall is expected in Robertsport and its environs.
- ❖ Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday (September 8–9): Moderate rainfall is expected in Robertsport and its environs.

Zwedru, Grand Gedeh County

- ❖ Thursday (September 4): Heavy rainfall is anticipated in Zwedru and its environs.
- ❖ Friday (September 5): Moderate rainfall is anticipated in Zwedru and its environs.
- ❖ Saturday and Sunday (September 6–7): Fair weather with light rainfall is anticipated in Zwedru and its environs.
- ❖ Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday (September 8–10): Moderate rainfall is anticipated in Zwedru and its environs, with an increase expected during the evening hours.

Gbarnga, Bong County

- ❖ Thursday and Friday (September 4-5): Heavy rainfall is expected in Gbarnga and its environs, with intensification during the evening hours.
- ❖ Saturday and Sunday (September 6–7): Fair weather with light rainfall is expected in Gbarnga and its environs.
- ❖ Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday (September 8-10): Heavy rainfall is expected in Gbarnga and its environs.

Sanniquellie, Nimba County

- ❖ Thursday and Friday (September 4–5): Heavy rainfall is anticipated in Sanniquellie and its environs, with intensification during the day.
- ❖ Saturday and Sunday (September 7-6): Fair weather with low rainfall is anticipated in Sanniquellie and its environs.
- ❖ Monday and Tuesday (September 8-9): Moderate rainfall is expected in Sanniquellie and its environs, with intensification during the evening hours.
- ❖ Wednesday (September 10): Heavy rainfall is expected in Sanniquellie and its environs.

Voinjama, Lofa County

- ❖ Thursday and Friday (September 4–5): Heavy rainfall is anticipated in Voinjama and its environs, with intensification during the afternoon hours.
- ❖ Saturday (September 6): Moderate rainfall is anticipated in Voinjama and its environs, with intensification during the afternoon hours.
- ❖ Sunday (September 7): Fair weather with low rainfall is anticipated in Voinjama and its environs.
- ❖ Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday (September 8-10): Moderate to heavy rainfall is anticipated in Voinjama and its environs, with intensification during the afternoon and evening hours.

Note:

The anticipated rainfall may cause localized flooding, particularly in low-lying and flood-prone areas. It may also create conditions favorable for mosquito breeding, increasing the risk of malaria cases in some regions. Residents are strongly advised to take the following precautions:

Stay informed by regularly monitoring official weather updates from the Liberia Meteorological Service (LMS) and other trusted sources such as:

- ✓ National Disaster Management Agency (NDMA)
- ✓ Liberia National Red Cross Society (LNRCS)
- ✓ Local radio and television stations

- ✓ Other recognized emergency communication platforms
- ❖ **Carry rain gear** like an umbrella, a raincoat, and waterproof footwear to stay dry and safe during sudden downpours and on slippery surfaces.
- ❖ **Ensure proper drainage** by clearing gutters, culverts, and other drainage systems around homes and communities to reduce water accumulation and minimize flood risks.
- ❖ **Protect your health** by taking antimalarial medications as prescribed or recommended by healthcare professionals, especially if you live in or plan to travel to high-risk areas.
- ❖ **Reduce mosquito populations** by fumigating your homes and surroundings to prevent the spread of malaria and other vector-borne diseases.
- ❖ **Maintain a clean environment** by eliminating ponds, properly disposing of waste, and keeping surroundings free of debris.
