WEEKLY WEATHER OUTLOOK VALID FROM SEPTEMBER 3 TO 9, 2025

Summary: During the period under review, the coastal areas such as Monrovia, Robertsport, and Greenville are expected to see heavy rain mainly between September 4 and 5, followed by periods of fair to moderate weather conditions. The interior counties such as Bong, Nimba, and Lofa will experience frequent heavy to moderate rainfall, especially from September 5 to 9, with intensification during the afternoon and evening hours. However, Buchanan, Zwedru, and parts of Sinoe will generally experience fairer weather conditions.

Monrovia/Montserrado County

- ❖ Wednesday (September 3): Fair weather with low rainfall is anticipated in Monrovia and its environs.
- ❖ Thursday and Friday (September 4–5): Heavy rainfall is anticipated in Monrovia and its environs.
- ❖ Saturday and Sunday (September 6–7): Fair weather with light rainfall is anticipated in Monrovia and its environs.
- ❖ Monday and Tuesday (September 8–9): Fair weather with moderate rainfall is anticipated in Monrovia and its environs

Buchanan, Grand Bassa County

- ❖ Wednesday and Thursday (September 3–4): Moderate rainfall is anticipated in Buchanan and its environs.
- ❖ Friday (September 5): Fair weather with low rainfall is anticipated in Buchanan and its environs.
- ❖ Saturday to Tuesday (September 6–9): Fair weather is expected in Buchanan and its environs

Greenville, Sinoe County

- ❖ Wednesday and Thursday (September 3–4): Moderate to heavy rainfall is anticipated in Greenville and its environs.
- ❖ Friday to Monday (September 5–8): Fair weather is anticipated in Greenville and its environs.

❖ Tuesday (September 9): Fair weather with low rainfall is expected in Greenville and its environs.

Robertsport, Grand Cape Mount County

- ❖ Wednesday (September 3): Fair weather with moderate rainfall is expected in Robertsport and its environs.
- ❖ Thursday and Friday (September 4–5): Heavy rainfall is expected in Robertsport and its environs.
- ❖ Saturday (September 6): Moderate rainfall is anticipated in Robertsport and its environs.
- Sunday (September 7): Fair weather with traces of rainfall is expected in Robertsport and its environs.
- ❖ Monday and Tuesday (September 8–9): Moderate rainfall is expected in Robertsport and its environs.

Zwedru, Grand Gedeh County

- ❖ Wednesday and Thursday (September 3–4): Moderate rainfall is anticipated in Zwedru and its environs.
- ❖ Friday to Sunday (September 5–7): Fair weather with light rainfall is anticipated in Zwedru and its environs.
- ❖ Monday and Tuesday (September 8–9): Moderate rainfall is anticipated in Zwedru and its environs, with an increase expected during the evening hours.

Gbarnga, Bong County

- ❖ Wednesday and Thursday (September 3–4): Moderate rainfall is expected in Gbarnga and its environs, with intensification during the evening hours.
- ❖ Friday (September 5): Heavy rainfall is anticipated in Gbarnga and its environs.
- ❖ Saturday and Sunday (September 6–7): Fair weather with light rainfall is expected in Gbarnga and its environs, with intensification during the afternoon hours.
- ❖ Monday (September 8): Heavy rainfall is expected in Gbarnga and its environs.
- ❖ Tuesday (September 9): Moderate to heavy rainfall is anticipated in Gbarnga and its environs.

Sanniquellie, Nimba County

- ❖ Wednesday to Friday (September 3–5): Heavy rainfall is anticipated in Sanniquellie and its environs, with intensification during the day.
- ❖ Saturday (September 6): Fair weather with moderate rainfall is anticipated in Sanniquellie and its environs.
- ❖ Sunday and Monday (September 7–8): Heavy rainfall is expected in Sanniquellie and its environs, with intensification during the evening hours.

❖ Tuesday (September 9): Fair weather with moderate rainfall is expected in Sanniquellie and its environs.

Voinjama, Lofa County

- ❖ Wednesday (September 3): Fair weather with low rainfall is anticipated in Voinjama and its environs.
- ❖ Thursday to Saturday (September 4–6): Moderate to heavy rainfall is anticipated in Voinjama and its environs, with intensification during the afternoon hours.
- ❖ Sunday to Tuesday (September 7–9): Moderate rainfall is anticipated in Voinjama and its environs, with intensification during the afternoon hours.

Note:

The anticipated rainfall may cause localized flooding, particularly in low-lying and flood-prone areas. It may also create conditions favorable for mosquito breeding, increasing the risk of malaria cases in some regions. Residents are strongly advised to take the following precautions:

Stay informed by regularly monitoring official weather updates from the Liberia Meteorological Service (LMS) and other trusted sources such as:

- ✓ National Disaster Management Agency (NDMA)
- ✓ Liberia National Red Cross Society (LNRCS)
- ✓ Local radio and television stations
- ✓ Other recognized emergency communication platforms
- ❖ Carry rain gear like an umbrella, a raincoat, and waterproof footwear to stay dry and safe during sudden downpours and on slippery surfaces.
- ❖ Ensure proper drainage by clearing gutters, culverts, and other drainage systems around homes and communities to reduce water accumulation and minimize flood risks.
- ❖ **Protect your health** by taking antimalarial medications as prescribed or recommended by healthcare professionals, especially if you live in or plan to travel to high-risk areas.
- * Reduce mosquito populations by fumigating your homes and surroundings to prevent the spread of malaria and other vector-borne diseases.
- ❖ Maintain a clean environment by eliminating ponds, properly disposing of waste, and keeping surroundings free of debris.
