WEEKLY WEATHER OUTLOOK VALID FROM SEPTEMBER 6 TO 12, 2025

Summary: During the review period, the majority of cities in Liberia are expected to experience fair weather on September 6 and 8. However, from September 9 to 10, most locations are likely to observe moderate to heavy rainfall, which may temporarily disrupt outdoor activities. Furthermore, between September 11 and 12, many cities are forecast to experience mixed weather conditions, including intervals of sunshine, cloudiness, and scattered showers.

Monrovia, Montserrado County

- ❖ Saturday and Sunday (September 6-7): Fair weather with low rainfall is anticipated in Monrovia and its environs.
- ❖ Monday (September 8): Fair weather with moderate rainfall is anticipated in Monrovia and its environs.
- ❖ Tuesday and Wednesday (September 9–10): Fair weather with low rainfall is anticipated in Monrovia and its environs.
- ❖ Thursday (September 11): Fair weather with moderate rainfall is anticipated in Monrovia and its environs.
- ❖ Friday (September 12) Fair weather with low rainfall is anticipated in Monrovia and its environs.

Buchanan, Grand Bassa County

- ❖ Saturday and Sunday (September 6–7): Fair weather with trace is expected in Buchanan and its environs.
- ❖ Monday (September 8): Moderate to heavy rainfall is expected in Buchanan and its environs.

- ❖ Tuesday (September 9): Fair weather with low rainfall is anticipated in Buchanan and its environs.
- ❖ Wednesday (September 10): Moderate rainfall is anticipated in Buchanan and its environs.
- ❖ Thursday (September 11): Fair weather with low rainfall is anticipated in Buchanan and its environs.
- Friday (September 12): Moderate rainfall is anticipated in Buchanan and its environs.

Greenville, Sinoe County

- ❖ Saturday (September 6): Fair weather with low rainfall is anticipated in Greenville and its environs.
- ❖ Sunday and Monday (September 7-8): Heavy rainfall is anticipated in Greenville and its environs.
- ❖ Tuesday and Wednesday (September 9-10): Moderate rainfall is anticipated in Greenville and its environs.
- ❖ Thursday and Friday (September 11-12): Heavy rainfall is expected in Greenville and its environs.

Robertsport, Grand Cape Mount County

- ❖ Saturday (September 6): Fair weather with low rainfall is expected in Robertsport and its environs.
- Sunday and Monday (September 7-8): Fair weather with traces of rainfall is expected in Robertsport and its environs.
- ❖ Tuesday (September 9): Fair weather with moderate rainfall is anticipated in Robertsport and its environs.
- ❖ Wednesday and Thursday (September 11-12): Heavy rainfall is anticipated in Robertsport and its environs.
- ❖ Friday (September 12): Moderate rainfall is anticipated in Robertsport and its environs.

Zwedru, Grand Gedeh County

❖ Saturday (September 6): Fair weather with light rainfall is anticipated in Zwedru and its environs.

- Sunday (September 7): Fair weather is anticipated in Zwedru during the morning hours. However, the evening hours will experience intense rainfall.
- ❖ Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday (September 8–10): Moderate rainfall is anticipated in Zwedru and its environs, with an increase expected during the evening hours.
- ❖ Thursday and Friday (September 11-12): Fair weather with low rainfall is expected in Zwedru and its environs.

Gbarnga, Bong County

- ❖ Saturday (September 6): Fair weather is expected in Gbarnga and its environs.
- Sunday (September 7): Fair weather is expected in Gbarnga during the morning hours; however, the evening hours will experience intense rainfall.
- ❖ Monday (September 8): Heavy rainfall is expected in Gbarnga and its environs.
- ❖ Tuesday and Wednesday (September 9-10): Moderate rainfall is anticipated in Gbarnga and its environs during the morning hours; however, the evening hours is expected to experience intense rainfall.
- ❖ Thursday and Friday (September 11-12): Moderate rainfall is anticipated in Gbarnga and its environs.

Sanniquellie, Nimba County

- ❖ Saturday (September 6): Fair weather with trace rainfall is anticipated in Sanniquellie and its environs.
- ❖ Saturday (September 7): Fair weather with low rainfall is anticipated in Sanniquellie and its environs; however, the evening hours will experience intense rainfall.
- ❖ Monday (September 8): Heavy rainfall is expected in Sanniquelle and its environs.
- ❖ Tuesday and Wednesday (September 8-9): Moderate rainfall is expected in Sanniquellie and its environs, with intensification during the evening hours.
- ❖ Wednesday (September 10): Heavy rainfall is expected in Sanniquellie and its environs.
- ❖ Thursday and Friday (September 11-12): Fair weather with low rainfall is expected in Sanniwuelle and its environs.

Voinjama, Lofa County

- Saturday (September 6): Fair weather is anticipated in Voinjama and its environs.
- Sunday (September 7): Fair weather is anticipated in Voinjama and its environs during the morning hours; however, the evening hours will experience intense rainfall.
- ❖ Monday (September 8): Heavy rainfall is anticipated in Voinjama and its environs.
- ❖ Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday (September 9-12): Moderate rainfall is expected in Voinjama and its environs during the morning hours; however, the evening hours will experience increase in rainfall.

Note:

The anticipated rainfall may cause localized flooding, particularly in low-lying and flood-prone areas. It may also create conditions favorable for mosquito breeding, increasing the risk of malaria cases in some regions. Residents are strongly advised to take the following precautions:

Stay informed by regularly monitoring official weather updates from the Liberia Meteorological Service (LMS) and other trusted sources such as:

- ✓ National Disaster Management Agency (NDMA)
- ✓ Liberia National Red Cross Society (LNRCS)
- ✓ Local radio and television stations
- ✓ Other recognized emergency communication platforms
- Carry rain gear like an umbrella, a raincoat, and waterproof footwear to stay dry and safe during sudden downpours and on slippery surfaces.
- Ensure proper drainage by clearing gutters, culverts, and other drainage systems around homes and communities to reduce water accumulation and minimize flood risks.
- ❖ **Protect your health** by taking antimalarial medications as prescribed or recommended by healthcare professionals, especially if you live in or plan to travel to high-risk areas.
- ❖ Reduce mosquito populations by fumigating your homes and surroundings to prevent the spread of malaria and other vector-borne diseases.
- ❖ Maintain a clean environment by eliminating ponds, properly disposing of waste, and keeping surroundings free of debris.
