# WEEKLY WEATHER OUTLOOK VALID FROM SEPTEMBER 10 TO 16, 2025

**Summary:** During the period under review, the majority of cities are expected to experience moderate rainfall between September 10 and 11. From September 12 to 13, most cities will observe intermittent rainfall, followed by heavy rainfall between September 14 and 16. However, cities such as Zwedru, Gbarnga, Saniquellie, and Voinjama are forecasted to receive heavy rainfall during this period. By contrast, coastal cities are expected to experience mixed weather conditions, including intervals of sunshine, cloudiness, and scattered showers.

#### Monrovia, Montserrado County

- ❖ Wednesday and Thursday (September 10-11): Heavy rainfall is anticipated in Monrovia and its environs.
- ❖ Friday and Saturday (September 12-13): Moderate rainfall is anticipated in Monrovia and its environs.
- Sunday (September 14): Fair weather with low rainfall is anticipated in Monrovia and its environs.
- ❖ Monday (September 15): Moderate rainfall is anticipated in Monrovia and its environs.
- ❖ Tuesday (September 16): Heavy rainfall is anticipated in Monrovia and its environs.

## **Buchanan, Grand Bassa County**

- ❖ Wednesday (September 10): Moderate rainfall is anticipated in Buchanan and its environs.

- ❖ Saturday (September 13): Heavy rainfall is anticipated in Zwedru and its environs, with an increase expected during the evening hours.
- Sunday (September 14): Moderate rainfall is expected in Zwedru and its environs.
- ❖ Monday (September 15): Heavy rainfall is anticipated in Zwedru and its environs.

## Gbarnga, Bong County

- ❖ Friday (September 12): Fair weather with low rainfall is anticipated in Gbarnga and its environs.
- ❖ Saturday and Sunday (September 13-14): Heavy rainfall is anticipated in Gbarnga and its environs.
- ❖ Monday and Tuesday (September 15-16): Moderate to heavy rainfall is anticipated in Gbarnga city and its environs. However, rainfall is expected to intensify during the evening service.

### Sanniquellie, Nimba County

- ❖ Wednesday (September 11): Heavy rainfall is expected in Sanniquellie and its environs, with intensification during the evening hours.
- ❖ Friday (September 12): Fair weather with low rainfall is expected in Sanniquellie and its environs.
- ❖ Saturday (September 13): Heavy rainfall is anticipated in Sanniquellie and its environs.
- Sunday (September 14): Moderate rainfall is anticipated in Sanniquellie and its environs.
- ❖ Monday and Tuesday (September 15-16): Moderate to heavy rainfall is anticipated in Sanniwuellie and its environs.

### Voinjama, Lofa County

- ❖ Wednesday and Thursday (September 10-11): Heavy rainfall is expected in Voinjama and its environs; however, rainfall will intensify during the evening hours.
- ❖ Friday (September 12): Fair weather with low rainfall is anticipated in Voinjama and its environs; however, rainfall may intensify during the evening.
- ❖ Saturday and Sunday (September 13-14): Moderate to heavy rainfall is anticipated in Vonijama and it environs; however, rainfall is expected to intensify during the evening hours.

Monday and Tuesday (September 15-16) Heavy rainfall is anticipated in Vonijama and its environs.

#### Note:

The anticipated rainfall may cause localized flooding, particularly in low-lying and flood-prone areas. It may also create conditions favorable for mosquito breeding, increasing the risk of malaria cases in some regions. Residents are strongly advised to take the following precautions:

Stay informed by regularly monitoring official weather updates from the Liberia Meteorological Service (LMS) and other trusted sources such as:

- ✓ National Disaster Management Agency (NDMA)
- ✓ Liberia National Red Cross Society (LNRCS)
- ✓ Local radio and television stations
- ✓ Other recognized emergency communication platforms
- Carry rain gear like an umbrella, a raincoat, and waterproof footwear to stay dry and safe during sudden downpours and on slippery surfaces.
- **Ensure proper drainage** by clearing gutters, culverts, and other drainage systems around homes and communities to reduce water accumulation and minimize flood risks.
- ❖ **Protect your health** by taking antimalarial medications as prescribed or recommended by healthcare professionals, especially if you live in or plan to travel to high-risk areas.
- \* Reduce mosquito populations by fumigating your homes and surroundings to prevent the spread of malaria and other vector-borne diseases.
- Maintain a clean environment by eliminating ponds, properly disposing of waste, and keeping surroundings free of debris.
