

Description:

Widespread fog is expected during the late night and early morning hours, particularly between 12:00 AM and 9:00 AM. Visibility may be reduced to less than 500 meters, especially along coastal highways, wetlands, and near river basins. Moist air from the Atlantic Ocean, combined with light winds and overnight cooling, is contributing to fog formation across several parts of the country. Advisory Fog conditions are expected to gradually improve by mid-morning as temperatures rise and visibility increases. However, localized fog patches may persist in low-lying areas. The public is strongly

advised to remain cautious and follow safety guidelines. The National Meteorological Service will continue monitoring conditions and provide updates as necessary. For further information, contact the National Meteorological Service or tune in to local radio announcements.

Instruction:

1. Motorists: o Reduce speed and maintain safe following distance. o Use low-beam headlights or fog lights. o Avoid sudden braking.
2. Motorcyclists & Pedestrians: o Wear reflective clothing where possible. o Exercise extreme caution when crossing highways.
3. Maritime Operators & Fishermen: o Use navigation lights and radar equipment. o Delay departure if visibility is severely reduced.
4. Air Transport Operators: o Monitor updated aviation weather briefings before takeoff and landing.
5. General Public: o Allow extra travel time during early morning hours. o Stay tuned to official weather updates.
